MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

Age: 18 years of age - no maximum age
Education: Proof of high school diploma or GED.
Physical: Good physical condition (pre-employment drug test and physical exam may be required)
Transportation: Must be able to consistently get to and from work and school
